For more than a century, Perrysburg Heights has been home to hardworking families who built a vibrant neighborhood despite generations of economic hardship and discrimination. In 1991, local residents came together to form the Perrysburg Heights Community Association (PHCA) - a grassroots effort to strengthen their community through education, wellness, and connection.

What We Do

- **Afterschool Education & Enrichment:** Veteran teachers lead reading and enrichment programs for 70+ students throughout the school year
- **Summer Camp:** Seven weeks of music, art, dance, and fitness for ages 5-12
- **Youth Development:** Heights Hoops basketball program builds skills, confidence, and teamwork
- **Job Connections:** Vocational and life-skills training for high school students, now in its 10th year
- **GED Preparation:** Adult classes offered in partnership with Penta Career Center
- **Family & Social Support:** Social worker-assisted counseling, parenting help, and access to essential resources
- **Health & Wellness:** Fitness classes, senior workouts, and free health screenings
- **Halim Clinic:** Free weekly primary care clinic for uninsured and underinsured adults
- **Islamic Food Bank Pantry at PHCA:** Weekly choice pantry serving 200+ people per month with fresh produce, meat, dairy, etc.
- **Mom's Mobile Mission:** Monthly support serving 60+ families with food bags, household essentials, and hygiene items
- **Community Facilities:** Open gym, fitness center, and pickleball courts
- **Special Events:** Family nights, holiday events, and neighborhood cleanups
